

9. The meeting got successfully concluded with the Vote of Thanks from the Chairperson.





f. Regarding the matter of having well defined Program outcomes and Course specific outcomes for both B. A. English (Hons.) programmes an M.A. English Program, the Coordinator read out the existing program outcomes of both the programs and it was approved by the members of the BOS. Besides, it was also resolved that the approved courses of both the programs would be distributed among the faculties of the department as per their expertise and they would be requested to prepare the course specific outcomes of their concerned courses.

4. External board members advised the internal members of BOS that the detailed progress report of the department in terms of quality enhancement should be thoroughly maintained by the department and should be submitted to the BOS committee in the next meeting for discussion.
